Ronald C. Auvenshine, B.A., D.D.S, Ph.D.

Dr. Auvenshine graduated from Baylor University in 1966 with B.A. in Chemistry. He graduated from Emory University School of Dentistry in Atlanta, Georgia in 1971. He holds a Ph.D. in Human Anatomy from LSU School of Medicine in New Orleans, graduating in 1976. Dr. Auvenshine's dissertation research involved the study of the embryonic development the relationship between structure and function of the temporomandibular joint. The "in utero" microsurgery technique he developed has yet to be duplicated. He was a faculty member at LSU School of Dentistry from 1976 to 1978. He was the Coordinator of Occlusion at LSUSD and established the first TMD/Orofacial Pain Clinic at LSU. In 1978, he relocated to Houston and established a private practice, which focuses on treating and managing

patients with craniomandibular and other facial pain disorders.

Dr. Auvenshine was a Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Orthodontics at the University of Texas School of Dentistry (Houston) from 1980 to 1988. He is currently an Adjunct Professor at UT Dental School in the Department of Restorative Dentistry and Biomaterials and lecturer in the graduate school. He is a founding Diplomate of the American Board of Orofacial Pain. Dr. Auvenshine is a past president of the American Academy of Orofacial Pain. He is also the founder and Director of the Orofacial Pain Clinic at the Michael E. DeBakey V.A. Hospital in Houston where he also serves as director of research for master's level residents.

He continues to lecture extensively in the field of TMD and chronic pain management both nationally and internationally. He serves on the editorial boards of the Journal of the Texas Dental Association and the J. of International Myopain Society. The Houston Chapter of the Academy of General Dentistry nominated Dr. Auvenshine for Texas Dentist of the year in 2003. Dr. Auvenshine served as President of the Greater Houston Dental Society in 2005-2006. He was presented the President's Award in 2003 for his leadership of the ADA's Tripartite Grassroots Membership initiative. Dr. Auvenshine's TGMI Committee was awarded the Golden Apple Award for 2003 by the American Dental Association. He was a member of the House of Delegates for the Texas Dental Association for 12 years and served on the Council on Membership of the American Dental Association (2005-2009) Dr. Auvenshine received the Distinguished Alumnus Award from Emory University School of Dentistry in March 2011. Dr. Auvenshine is on the faculty of the Institute of the American Academy of Craniofacial Pain (2009-present).
